The overall team size is 17, thereof 9 developers, 4 application support, and 4 business analysts. The team is split between Frankfurt and Prague, whereby we aim to shift more responsibilities to Prague in the future. Therefore, proficient communication in English is required, Czech and/or German is an advantage.

If you are still studying, we are offering part-time job, 70 % of full-time working hours is the minimum. This is targeted to students in the last grade who will be able to join us full time in one year latest. Full time from the very beginning is of course possible.

- Design and implementation of new web application using:
